

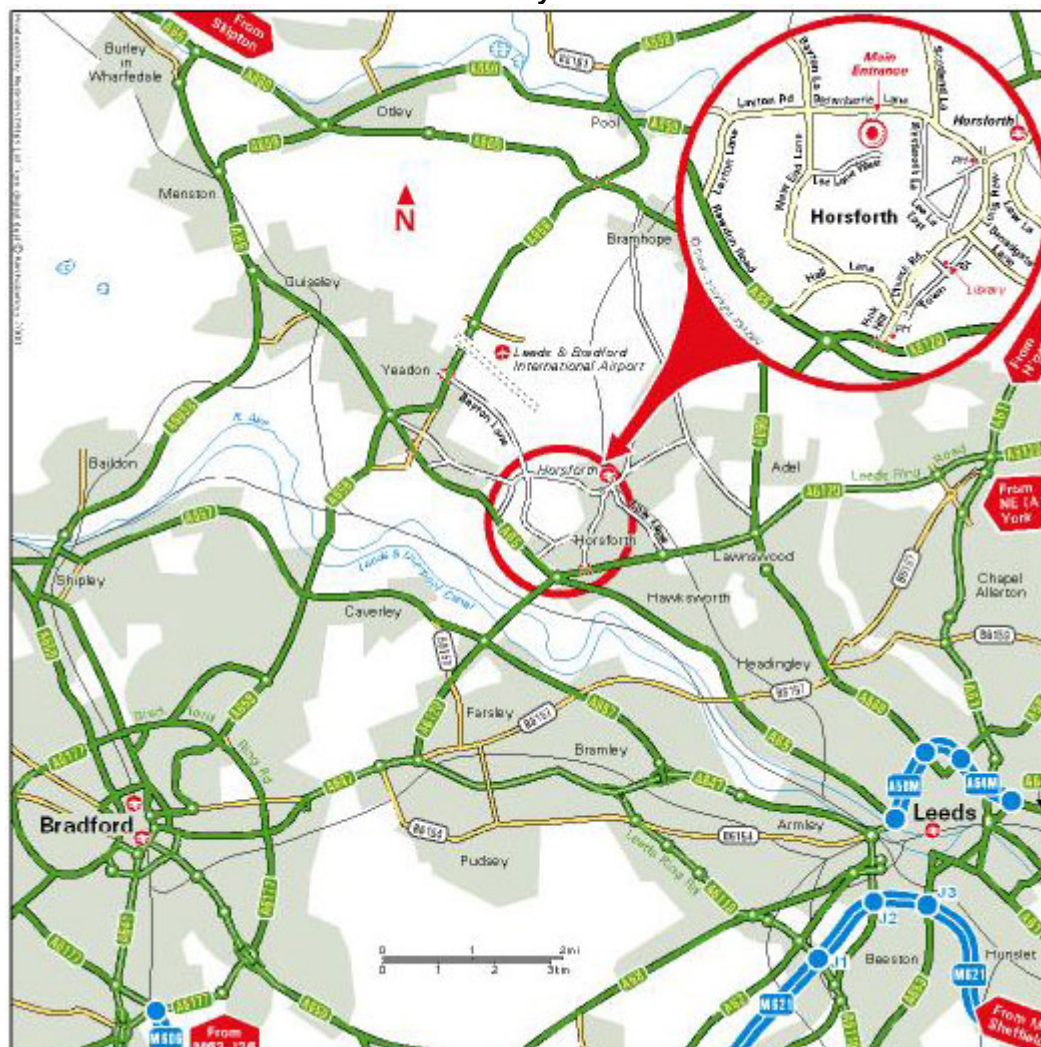


SCUTREA 2006: 36th Annual Conference
Inter-Cultural Perspectives on Research into Adult Learning: A Global Dialogue

Trinity and All Saints College, Leeds, UK
4th – 6th July 2006
Travel Information

Although the 2006 SCUTREA Conference is being organised by the University of Leeds, the conference is being held at one of its affiliate colleges, Trinity and All Saints College in Horsforth, a suburb about six miles to the northwest of the city of Leeds (See Map 1). This guidance suggests ways of getting to the conference site.

Map 1 The Conference site in relation to the city of Leeds



To get to Trinity and All Saints in Horsforth from Leeds, there are four main ways:

1. **By bus/coach**

The College is served by bus services between the City Centre and Horsforth. West Yorkshire bus routes 97, 97A and 731 travel from Leeds Central Bus Station (which is about 10 minutes walk from the Railway Station) and all stop outside the College on Brownberrie Lane. Metro's "Your Next Bus" initiative utilises GPS technology to allow mobile phone and internet users to find out when the next service will arrive. Timetables for these services are available by the cash point machine in the main College building or you can plan your journey on-line.

The city of Leeds is served by a network of National Express Coach Services from most major cities including London. The coaches arrive and leave from the bus station. Both London Heathrow and London Gatwick are served by coaches to and from Leeds. Journeys between Gatwick and Heathrow are connected by a regular coach service (allow one hour travelling time); there is a connecting service to Leeds-Bradford Airport from Heathrow (see air travel below) Journey times are around 6 to 7 hours (see below)

2. By train

Trinity & All Saints is situated approximately 1 mile from Horsforth station on the Leeds- Harrogate line. Leeds is well served by suburban rail lines and stations and it is easy to travel in or out of the city centre by train.

Passengers can now purchase a full range of rail tickets from Leeds Rail Station, or from Horsforth Station where there is a staffed ticket office and passengers can wait for trains in fully accessible, heated waiting rooms on both platforms.

Leeds Local and Regional Rail Network

Trains on the Leeds - Harrogate line stop at Horsforth Station (1 mile). Alternatively you may wish to take a taxi from Leeds City Station direct to the College (6 miles)

PLEASE NOTE:

On Monday 3 and Tuesday 4 July, any delegates arriving at Horsforth Railway Station may be picked up from the station by telephoning 0773 199 2825. If you are coming through Leeds Rail Station you are advised to book a through ticket to Horsforth. This courtesy request shuttle service will operate between 08:30 to 24:00 on Monday 3 July, and between 08:00 and 16:00 on Tuesday 4 July 2006. Taxis will need to be taken at other times.

Train services through Leeds:

Great North Eastern Railway (GNER)

GNER services run to and from London Kings Cross along the East Coast. Connections are made at York for journeys to / from Newcastle and Scotland. Call 0845 722 5225 for booking information. Journeys from London take from 2-3 hours. Journeys from Edinburgh will take just over three hours.

Virgin CrossCountry

CrossCountry trains run between Newcastle and Bristol (Temple Meads), via Birmingham New Street. Some trains extend beyond Bristol Temple Meads to Plymouth and/or Penzance. Others run to/from Edinburgh, about 90 minutes beyond Newcastle. Call 0345 222333 for booking information.

Midland Mainline

Some trains operated by Midland MainLine start from and terminate at Leeds. These trains run via Sheffield and Leicester to London St. Pancras. Call 0345 125768 for MML booking information.

Arriva Trains Northern

Arriva services run the local train services in West Yorkshire on behalf of Metro. These services are faster and are generally more comfortable for longer distance travel than the regular stopping regional services.

Indicative National Rail Network Journey Times:

Leeds - Bradford 20 minutes

Leeds – Manchester/Manchester Airport 1 hour/1 hr 20 mins

Leeds - Sheffield 45 minutes - 1 hour 20 minutes

Leeds - London 2 - 2.5 hours approx. (add one hour for journey from London Heathrow via Piccadilly Line to Kings Cross Rail Station on London Underground; or one and a quarter hours from London Gatwick via Thameslink Trains to London Kings Cross Rail Station – note: there is a five to ten minute walk between the Thameslink Station and the mainline station at Kings Cross

Leeds - Newcastle 1.5 - 2.5 hours approx

Leeds - Birmingham 2 hours

Leeds - Edinburgh 3 hours

Leeds-York 20-30 minutes

Leeds - Doncaster 30 minutes - 1 hour

Leeds - Liverpool 2 hours

3. By car

From the M1 Northbound (M62 Westbound Junct 29 & M621)

After the junction with the M62 the M1 becomes the M621. Continue on the M621, exit at Junction 2 and keeping to the left lane follow the signs for A58/Wetherby/York. Continue along this road (A643) and pick up the signs for the Airport. Follow the Airport signs until you join the A65 Ilkley/Skipton road out of Leeds . Continue for five miles passing Kirkstall Abbey on your left until you meet the Leeds Outer Ring Road (A6120) at a large roundabout with the Esso Garage on your right. Take the 3rd exit off this roundabout onto the A6120 heading towards York. Continue along this road

until you reach a set of traffic lights. The College is signposted here. Turn left into Fink Hill. Continue for one mile to arrive at a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit onto Brownberrie Lane and the college is located on the left approximately half a mile along this road.

From the M62 Eastbound

Leave the M62 at junction 26 to join the M606 towards Bradford. At the terminus roundabout of the M606 take the 4th exit to join the A6177 Bradford Ring Road towards Leeds/Bradford Airport. Continue over two roundabouts and at the junction with the A647 turn right towards Leeds. Proceed on the A647 to the roundabout junction on the Leeds Ring Road and turn left onto the A6120. Continue straight over a further two roundabouts and at the traffic lights turn left onto Fink Hill. Continue for one mile to arrive at a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit into Brownberrie Lane and the college is located on the left approximately half a mile along this road.

From the A1 (&NE) Southbound

Leave the A1 at Wetherby to join the A58 to Leeds . On reaching the A6120 (Ring Road) turn right and continue over three roundabouts. At the fourth roundabout turn right (notice the college signpost) onto Low Lane . Continue to a T junction (Horsforth Station entrance faces you).

Turn left to reach a roundabout. Take the 3 rd exit onto Brownberrie Lane and the college is located on the left approximately half a mile along this road.

Alternatively you can leave the A1 at Knaresborough and Harrogate (A59) and follow signs for Leeds./Bradford Airport. Go past the airport towards Bradford and take the next left turn, signposted to Trinity and All Saints College in Horsforth.

From Leeds City Centre

Follow the Airport signs onto the A65 Ilkley/Skipton road out of Leeds . Continue for five miles passing Kirkstall Abbey on your left until you meet the Leeds Outer Ring Road (A6120) at a large roundabout with the Esso Garage on your right. Take the 3rd exit off this roundabout onto the A6120 heading towards York . Continue along this road until you reach a set of traffic lights. The College is signposted here. Turn left into Fink Hill. Continue for one mile to arrive at a roundabout . Take the 2 nd exit onto Brownberrie Lane and the college is located on the left approximately half a mile along this road.
